Overview of Early Years Outcomes 2016 – 2017

Children in the Reception classes are assessed against the Early Learning Goals which provide school with a measure of a 'Good Level of Development.' Children are assessed as to whether they are 'emerging' (not yet at the expected level), expected or exceeding, (working beyond the expected level), in 17 areas of learning. This information also provides school with an average point score.
