



Next week our sound of the week will be 'a'. Please encourage your child to bring an object beginning with 'a' to put on our sound table. Please remember that it is the sound we are learning therefore aeroplane and acorn are not correct.

Our number of the week will be 2. The children will learn the following rhyme to help them to recognise the number 'around and back on a railroad track two, two, two'.

Next week's learning: Our key text will be 'Kipper's Birthday'. The children will be introduced to Polly (the Nursery puppet). As it is going to be Polly's birthday soon, the children will help to plan a party for her. Over the next few weeks, the children will be involved in making decorations, a birthday card and an invitation. They will make Polly a cake, write party food lists and role play birthday parties. Our birthday topic will also allow the children to explore number and shape.

Polly's party will take place on Tuesday 28th November during the nursery sessions. Party clothes can be worn on this day. Details about party food will be sent out later.

Our new class target is: To remember to put our picture on our drink when we arrive in nursery and remember to have our drink and snack through the nursery session. The children agreed that they would like to have toast and tea as their reward. Can we ask that you please support your child to put their picture on their drink on arrival.
