Congratulations to everyone in **Panthers** class for achieving the highest class attendance this week.

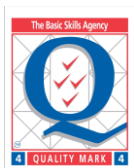
This week's class attendance figures are:

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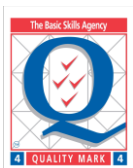
