The Governing Body of Lee Brigg agreed to the issuing of fixed penalty notices for unauthorised absences which may include holidays taken in term time. This was agreed in July 2013 and remains part of the school policy. It had been suspended in light of a case highlighted in the media, however the resolution of that case reverts school decisions back to the current attendance policy in place.
